Islamabad (July 13, 2012: In a press statement issued today the Naib Amir of Jamaat-e-Islami Pakistan ex-Senator Prof. Khurshid Ahmad has expressed his deep sorrow and disappointment for sending Dr. Ghulam Nabi Fai Chairman Kashmir American Council to prison for two years and further surveillance for three years.

"This is a travesty of justice and an eye opening example of duplicity and hypocrisy of the American Establishment", Prof. Khurshid stressed and added that even the Court which has sentenced Dr. Fai has acknowledged his character, commitment and selfless services to the cause of the oppressed people in Indian Occupied Kashmir and his struggle for their right of self-determination. "Does America want to be reminded how many lobbies, organizations, and individuals are engaged in promoting their causes some of which are not only unjust but outrageous?", Prof. Khurshid questioned and added that how the Zionists, extreme rightists and Indian agents are operating openly in America, is not a secret.

Prof. Khurshid observed that targeting Dr. Fai seems to be a part of the US-Indian strategic partnership whose one target is to pressurize Pakistan. "If the PPP led-Pakistan Government cannot see this it can only be described as a national calamity", he emphasized.

Prof. Khurshid appealed to the OIC, Pakistan and Muslim Governments and all those organizations which stand for human rights and right to self-determination in occupied lands to protest against this miscarriage of justice and political onslaught on the right of the oppressed people.
